

Bastrop County Commissioner's Court Meeting Minutes: April 7, 1887

(establishing the location of the bridges)

It is remembered that on this the 7th day of April A.D. 1887 there was begun and holden a special Term of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Bastrop County present and presiding his Honor Syer Moore County Judge, Albert Jones T. A. Casler J. W. Shortt and N. S. Cruggs County Commissioners, H. A. Bell Sheriff W. Jenkins County Clerk

Court was opened by the Sheriff making proclamation at the Court house door

The Court having been opened the Honorable Judge Syer Moore explained the object of the meeting was to locate by designating the place over each and every stream the Bridges proposed to built in this County, whereupon the Court made the following Order -

It is ordered that the new bridges to be built be located at the following points on the following streams to wit - 1. On Cedar Creek near R. J. Price at or near the site of the old Bridge - 2. On Cedar Creek at the Crossing of Austin & Port Lavaca Road - 3. - On Sandy Creek at the Old Bridge site - 4. - On Millbarger Creek at the Old Bridge site - It is further ordered by the Court that the County Judge enter into Contract with J. S. Cassett on the Terms proposed by him to prepare Plans & Specifications and superintend the construction of the Bridges

Issd It is Ordered and decreed by the Court that the acco of Hon Syer Moore of \$10⁰⁰ for amt. paid Galveston News a vesting Bridge Bonds be and is hereby allow

Issd McSade & Olive Store Road - Precinct N^o 25 It is Ordered and decreed by the Court that O. H. Coulson be and he is hereby appointed Overseer of this road precinct and that he have all hands heretofore assigned
