The County Judge explained the object of the Special meeting to be to receive and examine bids for the construction of certain bridges in Bastrop County - Whereupon the Court proceeded to examine such bids, and ascertained that the Kansas City Bridge and Iron Company of Kansas City State of Missouri had offered the lowest bid to wit for the sum of Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty Nine (\$12,829⁰⁰) Dollars - It is therefore ordered that the bid of said Company be and the same is hereby accepted and that said Company be and it is hereby authorized to construct said bridges - It is further ordered that J^m Bassett be and he is hereby authorized to enter into Contract with said Company for the construction of said Bridges and to sign the same on behalf of Bastrop County -
